# **KNOWLEDGE SHARING WORKSHOPS**

## **A. For students “Fun with science”**

25<sup>th</sup> September, 2024

A thrilling science workshop , led by scientist Mr. Gijo Raj , a renowned Scientist C, Division of Polymeric Medical Devices, Department of Medical Devices Engineering, Biomedical Technology Wing, Sree Chitra Trunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology, Trivandrum introduced students of std VI to XII to the fascinating world of physics. Through hands-on experiments, students explored scientific concepts that explain everyday life. The magnetic pendulum demonstrated magnetic forces in motion, while the magic fountain showcased principles of fluid dynamics. Optical illusions and the kaleidoscope revealed how light behaves and forms patterns. Students marveled at the reflection of light as observed in the Konark temple and learned about centrifugal force, which explains rotational motion. Additionally, the study of sound

amplitude demonstrated how vibrations produce different sound levels. This engaging session made science enjoyable by unveiling the secrets of physics, leaving students with a deeper appreciation for the subject.





## B. for Teachers

Anger Management School Workshop the key take away from the workshop were as follows:

- **Control Anger:** Learn techniques to manage anger before reacting.
- **Understand the Situation:** Avoid making assumptions or jumping to conclusions.
- **Listen First:** Prioritize listening to students' perspectives before responding.
- **Effective Communication:** Use calm and clear communication when addressing students.
- **Empathy:** Show empathy and understanding towards students' feelings and situations.
- **Avoid Assumptions:** Do not make hasty judgments without fully understanding the context.
- **Patience:** Practice patience and take a moment to process before reacting.
- **Positive Reinforcement:** Encourage positive behaviour and responses in students.

These strategies help in creating a supportive and effective learning environment.
